What is Lethbridge LIP? Funded by Immigration Refugees and Citizenship Canada

(IRCC), Lethbridge LIP is a community development initiative which began in June 2016. Our goal is to identify and reduce barriers facing newcomers and ensuring that we are providing a welcoming and inclusive community for all who call Lethbridge home. There are 77 LIP's in communities across Canada. Lethbridge LIP has one coordinator and 5 committees.

What is the IAT? The IAT is a committee of LIP. It consists of a maximum of 12 community volunteers who have lived immigrant experience.

Who is eligible to apply to the IAT?

- Adults over the age of 18
- Not born in Canada
- Are planning to live in Lethbridge or surrounding area for the next 1-2 years.

What does the IAT do?

- The IAT assists the LIP initiative in a number of ways. The main purpose is to help direct and guide the work of the LIP by providing the immigrant perspective. Past projects include assisting with the LIP website, needs assessment and strategic plan.

Why is there an application and interview process?

What if I am not chosen to be on IAT?

 We would love to have everyone who applies to join us on the IAT however we do need to ensure our diversity requirements. We will still invite you to participate in projects and other opportunities when they arise. We will also consider your application again, if we have openings.

What is the time commitment? Two hours once per month: Joining other committees and projects under the LIP umbrella is optional.
